QSPainRelief’s first patient event took place as part of Pain Alliance Europe’s (PAE; <https://pae-eu.eu/>) annual General Assembly (GA) Meeting this year: The project’s scientific coordinator, Prof. Dr. Liesbeth de Lange from University of Leiden presented the scope of the project in a 20-min video lecture on **Wednesday, 24 June 2020**. The video provides an introductory overview about the need for more personalised, and effective combinational treatments for chronic pain patients, the project’s key goals and its methodological approach.

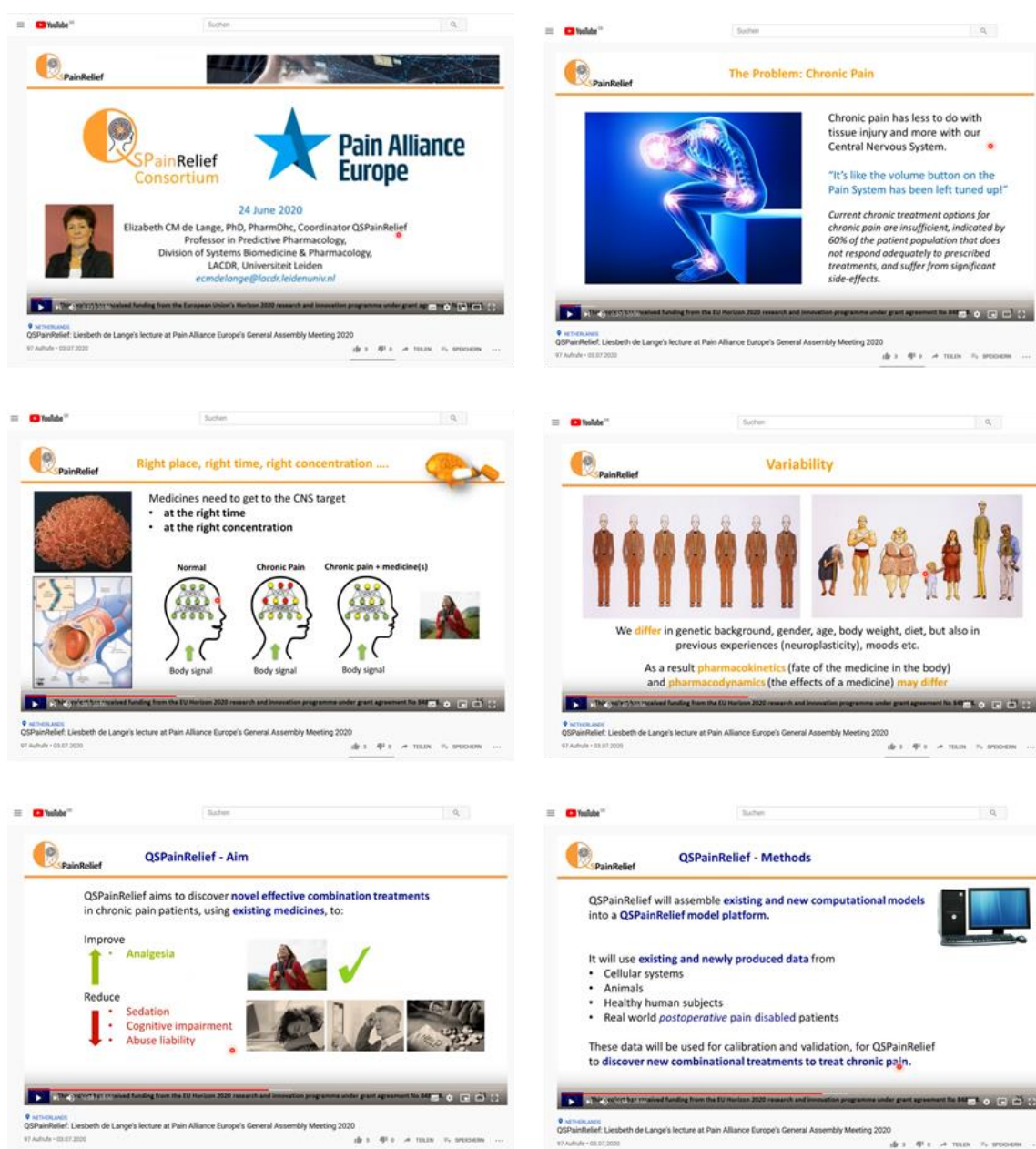


Figure 1: Screenshots from the QSPainRelief project video.
