Kdo upravlja ORE?

ORE je vzpostavila Evropska komisija, tehnično ga upravlja podjetje F1000 Research

Pri delovanju ORE sodeluje mednarodni znanstveni svetovalni odbor (Scientific Advisory Board (SAB), ki EK in F1000 nudi podporo pri zagotavljanju visokih znanstvenih standardov platforme (<https://open-research-europe.ec.europa.eu/advisors/>).

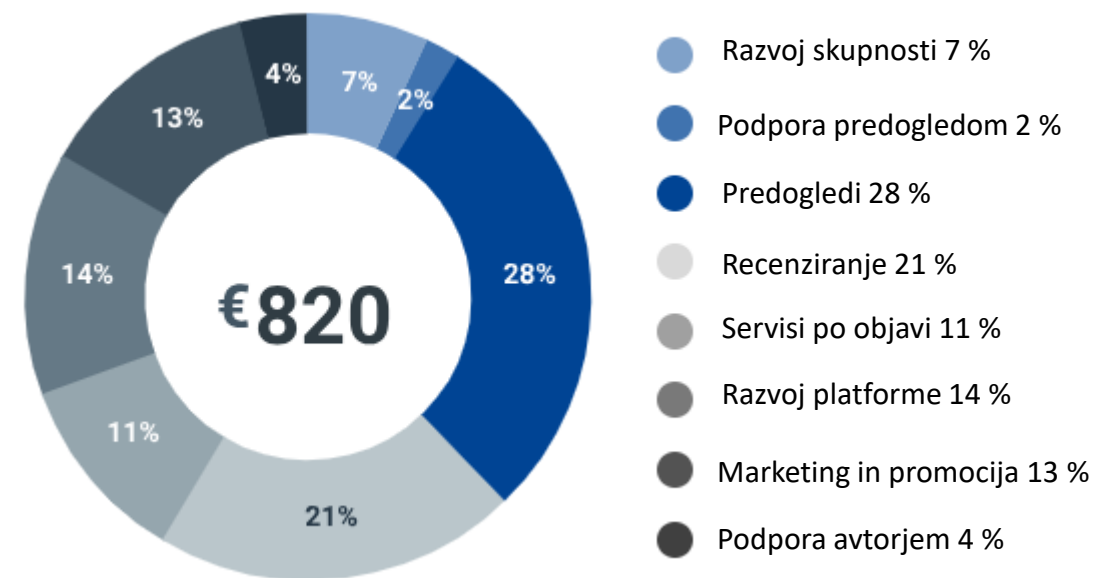

Ali ima ORE dejavnik vpliva?

ORE se ne zavzema za kakršnakoli kvantitativna merila platforme in ne spodbuja povečevanja kakršnegakoli dejavnika vpliva.

ORE spodbuja odgovorno uporabo meril, povezanih z raziskavami, in njihovo uporabo pri ocenjevanju znanstvenoraziskovalnega dela v skladu z Leidenskim manifestom, deklaracijo DORA in aktivnostmo koalicije COARA.

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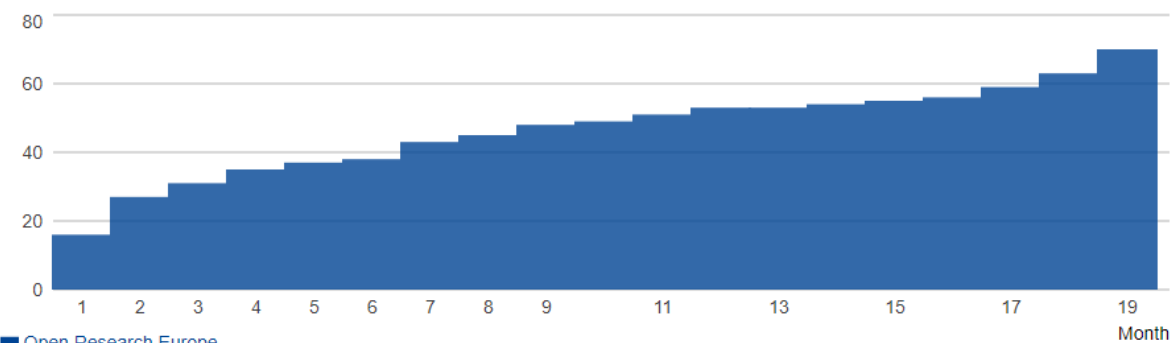

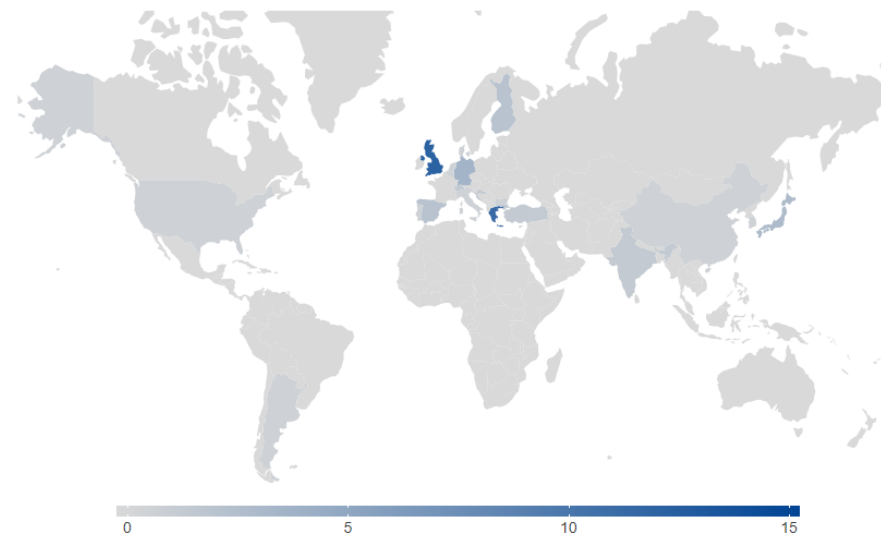
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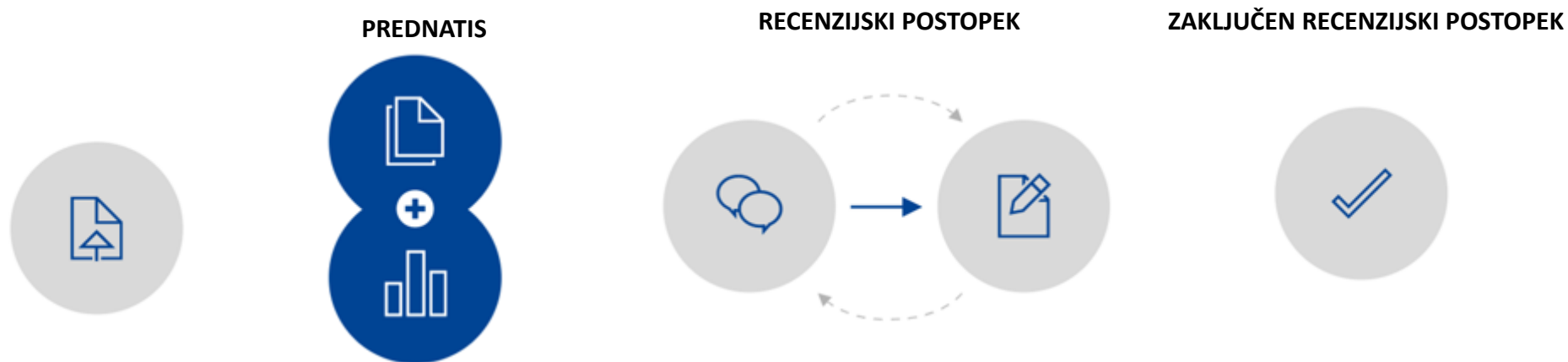
Licence v ORE

Oddaja članka

Objava članka in arhiviranje podatkov

Ko članek preverjanja pred objavo, je prednatis **v 10 dneh** objavljen in omogoča takojšen ogled in navajanje. **Ko je članek objavljen, ga za razliko od drugih prednatisov ni mogoče poslati v drugo revijo za objavo.**

Odprti recenzijski pregled in revizija članka

Izbrani so in povabljeni ekspertni ocenjevalci - recenzenti, njihovi prispevki in imena pa so objavljeni ob članku skupaj z odgovori avtorjev in komentarji registriranih uporabnikov. Avtorji so povabljeni, da objavijo popravljene različice svojega članka. Vse različice članka so povezane in neodvisno citirane.

Indeksiranje in pretočnost

Članki, ki so v recenzijskem postopku ustrezno ocenjeni, so indeksirani v pomembnih splošnih in specialnih bibliografskih indeksih ter v agregatorjih znanstvenih vsebin.



Preverjanje pred objavo

Avtorska merila: Vsaj en avtor mora sodelovati v tekočem ali zaključenem projektu Evropske komisije Horizon 2020, Horizon Europe, COST Action ali Euratom, članek pa mora biti rezultat tega projekta.

Vrste člankov: članki morajo ustrezati eni izmed znanstvenih tipologij.

Izvirnost: Članki morajo biti izvirni. Delo ali njegovi pomembni deli ne smejo biti objavljeni že prej ali biti trenutno v obravnavi drugje (to ne velja za prednatis). ORE za preverjanje plagiatorstva v člankih uporablja Crossrefov program za preverjanje podobnosti (iThenticate).

Jezik in berljivost: Članki morajo biti napisani v jasnem jeziku, tako da lahko bralci brez težav sledijo predstavljenim informacijam in argumentom.

Metode: Podrobno morajo biti opisane metode in viri, da je delo mogoče oceniti.

Raziskovalni podatki: Vsi članki morajo vključevati izjavo o dostopnosti podatkov, tudi če s člankom niso povezani nobeni podatki. Vsi članki, ki poročajo o izvirnih rezultatih, morajo vključevati neobdelane podatke, na katerih temeljijo ti rezultati. Te je treba v odprti obliki naložiti v podatkovno skladišče z licenco in trajnim identifikatorjem, ki drugim omogoča ponovno uporabo v skladu z načeli FAIR Data.



Recenzentski postopki v ORE 1

Odprte recenzije („open peer review“).

Recenzentski postopek se začne po objavi.

Postopek je popolnoma odprt in pregleden: vsak pregled skupaj s statusom odobritve, ki ga izbere recenzent, se objavi v članku skupaj z imenom in afiliacijo recenzenta.

Po uredniškem pregledu recenzije ter po reviziji članka v skladu z recenzijo, je recenzija tudi objavljena.



Recenzentski postopki v ORE 1

Za določitev ustreznega recenzenta so odgovorni avtorji, ki morajo pred objavo predlagati vsaj pet ekspertov - potencialnih recenzorjev ob upoštevanju kriterijev.

ORE nudi tudi pomoč pri iskanju ustreznih recenzentov (<https://open-research-europe.ec.europa.eu/for-authors/tips-for-finding-referees/>)

Recenzijo izvajata dva izbrana recenzenta.

Ko so recenzenti izbrani, jih kontaktira uredniški odbor, ki vodi recenzijski postopek.

Možnosti v primeru negativnih recenzij

Recenzenti ocenijo, da objavljeni članek ni znanstveno utemeljen ali da ga je treba bistveno spremeniti, preden se lahko šteje za utemeljenega.

Članek ni nikoli "zavrnen" in avtorji lahko predložijo popravljeno različico članka, ki upošteva kritike recenzentov brez časovnih omejitev.

Avtorji lahko kadar koli zagovarjajo svoje delo s komentarjem, ki je objavljen kot odgovor na kritično recenzijo.

Če avtorji menijo, da je bil recenzent neupravičeno negativen do njihovega dela, lahko zahtevajo tudi novega recenzenta za prvotno ali revidirano različico svojega članka.

Kriteriji za izbor recenzentov v ORE

Pri izbiri recenzorjev morajo avtorji upoštevati tri temeljne kriterije:

1. Ekspertno znanje na področju raziskave: recenzenti morajo izkazati ekspertno znanje na področju, ki jo raziskava obravnava. Imeti morajo vsaj tri objave kot vodilni avtorji in vsaj eno objavo članka s področja v zadnjih petih letih.
2. Izkušnje: recenzenti morajo imeti ustrezen nivo izobrazbe (običajno doktorat znanosti), v okviru svoje afiliacije pa naj imajo formalen naziv oz. imenovanje.
3. Odprava konflikta interesov: recenzenti naj ne pripada isti afiliaciji kot avtor ter naj z avtorjem ne sodeluje tako na profesionalni kot zasebni ravni. Neobstoje konflikta interesov recenzenti potrdijo z izjavo.

Kdaj šteje, da je članek sprejet v objavo

Stanje recenzije in status članka sta jasno označena na vseh stopnjah:

- Takoj ob objavi in do objave prvega strokovnega pregleda je članek označen kot Awaiting Peer Review - kot del naslova članka in v polju za povzetek recenzije.
- Takoj ko je ob članku objavljena vsaj ena recenzija, se prikaže trenutni status odobritve. Ko prejmete dodatne recenzije, se status odobritve posodobi.
- Možni statusi odobritve so APPROVED, APPROVED WITH RESERVATIONS in NOT APPROVED.



Statusi recenzijskega postopka

APPROVED - eksperimentalna zasnova je ustrezna; rezultati so natančno predstavljeni, zaključki pa utemeljeni in podkrepljeni s podatki.

APPROVED WITH RESERVATIONS – znanstveno delo je utemeljeno, a je zahtevano večje število manjših sprememb članka ali večje revizije.

NOT APPROVED – znanstveno delo ima temeljne pomanjkljivosti in je na splošno slabe kakovosti. Članek ostane objavljen, avtorje so pozvani, da svoj članek pregledajo, da se odzovejo na pomisleke recenzenta.

Abstract

While Slovenia has significant bioeconomy potential, it remains underutilized, facing challenges in primary bioeconomy sectors, their integration along value chains, uptake of industrial innovation, and institutional coordination. This paper aims to support the unlocking of Slovenia's bioeconomy potential, and foster sustainable and integrated development of its value chains. It provides the evidence base of the composition, volumes and current utilization of the available biomass streams from agriculture, forestry and aquatic systems. It discusses the potential uses of these resources and highlights the need for improved logistics and scalability. Additionally, the structure and performance of bioeconomy-related industries in Slovenia are examined, emphasizing the importance of firm consolidation and integration for successful bioeconomy development. It emphasizes the importance of sector-specific transformation pathways, from primary production to expanding hybrid sectors. The exchange between policymakers and stakeholders is encouraged to recognize synergies, accelerate cooperation, and improve economic performance while closing material and energy loops. The document also reviews the supporting environment for bioeconomy development and proposes steps for improved coordination and strategic planning.

I really like the idea of a paper that focuses on the accuracy and the precision of the threshold measurements made. In some cases where it is difficult to know the energy distribution in the laser beams, these are supposed to be "perfectly" Gaussian at the focus of a lens. This is not always strictly the case, and the small deviation from this assumption can lead to large errors when Liu's method is used to determine the thresholds (ablation and/or damage thresholds) of a material or even the diameter of a beam. Therefore, the authors had the clever idea of rendering the beam of perfectly known shape
